

Enters Elite Dangerous, ED, with a new installation of Odyssey on a Win10 system.

I want to use 1 Thrustmaster 16000M and 1 Logitech Extreme 3D PRO 1 mouse and 1 Keyboard as inputs.

Cables from TM and LT were first connected directly to each USB socket in an USB hub.

Later, they were connected directly to each USB port on my pc. (I read some suggestion to do that).

After a short time, some issues pops up:

- * Assignments to control setting in ED seemed to dissapear

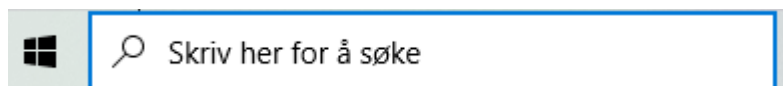
- *ED seemes to not react at all on any of my input sources (joysticks, mouse, keyboard

- * I started to believe that ED couldnt differ between the 2 joysticks. In ED it doesent show but by reading in the CUSTOM.4..... xml file You will notice ED set the correct joystick for thee chosen assignments.

An option by name "CUSTOM" was randomly present. (The option I thought I had to use with my input sources).

So after approx. 3 days I wrote to Frontier support and got an answer that seemes to solve the above issues:

Look for this searchbox on Your pc. (probably down left bar in Windows.



Write following into searchbox: %appdata% ,and click Enter-key

Something like this should be shown:



(You will read username instead of xxx).

Doubleclick on AppData shown above

Then doubleclick on Local

Then doubleclick on Frontier Developements (notice space in Elite Dangerous).

Doubleclick on Elite Dangerous.

Doubleclick on Options.

Take a copy of directory named Bindings and save it on a memorystick and disconnect the memorystick from PC.

Delete directory named Bindings (permanently in trashcan).

Turn off pc and delay for a minute.

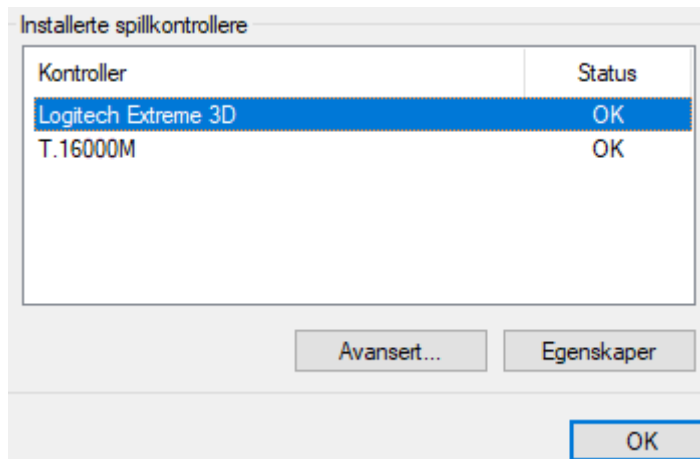
Connect 2 joysticks (directly?) into your pc.

Turn ON pc.

Then write USB in the same field (searchbox) as You used at start.

You should see some like this in a window but in your own language.

Click on the button right over the OK button and You can test buttons,switches on the joysticks.



Now, start the game Elite Dangerous. (Im not on Steam).

Navigate to the Option directory as You did above. You will now, hopefully, notice game has made a new Bindings directory. (But still cant see any files named Custom.4.... (Custom.3.. for Horizon) in the Bindings directory).

So I clicked on the "KEYBOARD & MOUSE" option in "GENERAL CONTROLS" and added a joystick binding (Yaw) then clicked on Apply.

Now the Custom option became visible in the Shipcontrols panel.



I saved the Bindings directory

I did enter ED approx 50 times configuring bindings without any issues.
